Miss Rose Simmer<sup>1</sup>

Miss Rose Simmer, 80, for many years a dressmaker in this village, died Saturday after noon at St. Mary's hospital, Amsterdam, where she had been a patient for about two weeks.

She was born January 2, 1860, in the Town of Palatine, a daughter of John and Elizabeth Nieholtz Simmer, and had always lived in this section.

She is survived by three brothers, Charles and William Simmer, Fort Plain, and John Simmer of White Plains.

The funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at the Catherine Nellis Memorial Chapel, the Rev. William A. Haney, pastor of the Universalist church officiating. Interment in the Fort Plain cemetery.
