William Simmer<sup>1</sup>

William Simmer, aged 64 years, died on Tuesday morning in St. Mary's Hospital, Amsterdam. Mr. Simmer had been a patient at the hospital for the past ten weeks. He was born in the Town of Minden September 2, 1876, the son of John and Elizabeth Nieholtz Simmer, and had spent his entire life in this town. He conducted a plumbing and heating business for many years.

The survivors are two brothers, Charles Simmer, of Fort Plain, and John Simmer, of White Plains, one nephew and one niece.

The remains were brought to the A. O. Swartz and Son Funeral Home from where the funeral will be held on Friday, February 14th at 1:30, the Rev. William A. Haney, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist Church, officiating.

The remains will be placed in the vault at the Catherine Nellis Memorial Chapel until Spring, when interment will be made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
