Herkimer, Jan.^[sic] 3—Mrs. Clayton L. Slawson passed away suddenly and unexpectedly at 6 o'clock this morning, having been ill only a day. Mrs. Slawson's maiden name was Carrie E. Kenyon. She was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. J. [Edgar J. and Addie Morey] Kenyon of King street, and was born in Newport 22 years ago. The family came to this village in 1896 and she had since been a resident here. Besides her bereaved husband and her parents, there are surviving a sister, Miss Reba Kenyon, and a brother, Harold Kenyon. The blow falls heavily on Mr. Slawson, who is just recovering from an extended illness. The funeral will be held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock and will be private. Rev. C. [Charles] E. Bingham [Universalist] will officiate and the remains will be placed in the vault of Oak Hill Cemetery.
