WEEDSPORT NATIVE DIES IN SYRACUSE

Mrs. Genevieve M. Sleight, 704 Allen St., Syracuse, widow of William A. Sleight, died in her home March 19. She was a former teacher of dramatic art in Ohio and Syracuse, maintaining her own studios.

A native of Weedsport, Mrs. Sleight was graduated from Syracuse University in 1917. She received a master's degree in dramatic art at Western Reserve University in England. She and her late husband lived in Cleveland for a number of years before coming to Syracuse in 1927.

Mrs. Sleight was a member of the First Universalist Church of Syracuse, Zeta Phi Eta sorority at Syracuse University and the Boars Head honorary society.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Virgil Armstrong and Mrs. Harold H. Follett, both of Syracuse, and a brother, David Sayles.

A private memorial service was conducted at the residence at the convenience of the family. Officiating was Rev. Dr. Ellsworth C. Reamon, pastor of the First Universalist Church.
