This community was much shocked on hearing of the death of Theodore Sleight, which occurred in Bristol on the 2d inst. His age was 25. He died of typhoid fever, and owing to the malignity of the disease, physicians order the body interred the night after his death. He was buried in Lakeview cemetery, Honeoye [Town of Richmond]. Mr. Sleight had always lived in this town until his removal to Bristol about two years ago. His parents are Theodore and Julia Sleight. He leaves a wife [Hattie Haney(?) Sleight] and son [Theodore H. Sleght: spelling change]. He was a young man of much energy and ambition, and his early death is lamented by all who knew him. His parents and wife have the sympathy of all in their sudden bereavement. The funeral services will be held from the Universalist church in Bristol on the 14th.
