Mrs. Catharine McKeown Small, 63, formerly of Utica, died yesterday in her home, 10 Richlieu Place, Montreal, Canada.

She was born in Albany, daughter of O. Judd and Elizabeth Gloeckner McKeown. She attended Utica schools and was a graduate of the Sea Pines (Mass.) Finishing School. She was married to Gordon S. Small in Utica in 1930. The couple then moved to Montreal.

Mrs. Small was a director of the Canadian National Ballet, the Garden Club of Montreal, and in Utica, was a member of the [Universalist] Church of the Reconciliation.

Besides her husband, she leaves a daughter, Mrs. Glen Tornay, and a son, James K. Small, both of Montreal, and two sisters, Mrs. Helen McKee and Mrs. Ruth King, both of Utica.

A funeral service will be conducted at 11 Friday at the conservatory of Forest Hill Cemetery, Utica, with the Rev. Herbert H. Hudson, pastor of the Church of the Reconciliation officiating. Burial will be in Forest Hill Cemetery.
