HASKINVILLE

Thomas Smart died suddenly at his home near this village Feb. 24, 1902. Mr. Smart was born in Scotland, June 29, 1851, coming to this country with his parents when two years of age and settling in Otsego Co. N.Y., and later coming to Steuben Co. [On] May 1, 1881, he married Miss Sarah Coddington of Fremont. She having died July 26, 1891, he married Miss Lottie Harris of Naples, who survives him together with six children, one of which is by his first wife. He also leaves a stepfather, George Wright, Sr., one own brother, Alex. Smart of South Dansville, one step-brother, George Wright, Jr. of Hornellsville, three step-sisters, Mrs. Harmon Cooley and Mrs. Henry Jenks of Wallace, and Mrs. B.W. Green of Haskinville. The funeral was held Feb. 27, at the Lake church, Rev. I. [Isaac] K. Richardson [Universalist] of Cohocton, conducting the services. The K.O.T.M. [Knights of the Maccabees] of Haskinville attended in a body and took part in the ceremony. Interment in the Lake cemetery [Lakeside Cemetery in Wayland].
