Mrs. Adelia A. Smith

Fort Plain, Feb. 4—The friends of Mrs. Adelia A. Smith were saddened to hear of her death which occurred Sunday at the Little Falls hospital, where she had been for the past two months. Death was due to the infirmities of old age. Mrs. Smith was 84 years old. She was born at Nelliston and was a daughter of Jacob W. Nellis and Anna Eliza Nellis. She was the widow of Dwight Smith. Many years ago Mrs. Smith went to Little Falls with her husband where they resided for several years. Later they became inmates [residents] of the Masonic Home at Utica. Several years ago Mrs. Smith left the home and has since lived in Little Falls. She is the last of a large family. Three nephews survive, Clyde Nellis, Jacob Nellis and Harry Nellis, of Nelliston. The body was brought to the home of Mrs. Grace Nellis in Nellis and the funeral will be held there Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Frank Moulton, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. The interment will be in the Fort Plain cemetery.
