Morris, April 24.—Albert Smith, an old and respected resident of the Butternut Valley, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. George [Jennie J.] Newton, on Friday, April 19, aged 85 years. He has lived for the most of the time in the town of New Lisbon and part of the time with his daughter on the farm just below the village, where he died and had been cared for during his last sickness. He was a devoted member of the Universalist church and always in attendance when his health permitted. He is survived by his daughter named above and one son, Justice [Justus] Smith of this town. His funeral was held on Sunday afternoon from the Universalist church, his pastor, Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Leonard, officiating.
