OBITUARY

Mrs. Charlotte R. Smith, wife of William B. Smith, formerly of this village, and for years Superintendent and engineer on the C. & S. V. R. R., died at the home of her daughter Mrs. Charles S. Dodge at Muskegon, Mich., on Wednesday of last week. The remains were brought to this village for interment on Saturday and the funeral services were conducted on that day from her late home on Leatherstocking street, the Rev. Mr. Perry officiating.

Mrs. Smith was the daughter of Almon White of Springfield in this county, and was born July 2, 1821. She was married Dec. 1, 1839, and leaves her husband and three children to mourn her departure: Almon W. of Jersey Shore, Pa., Scott F. Smith Of Boston, and Mrs. Charles S. Dodge of Muskegon, Mich. Mrs. Smith came to this village with her husband from Corning, N. Y., in 1869, and with the exception of about one year they lived in Cooperstown until 1895.

Mrs. Smith was a member of the Universalist church in this village, a Christian woman of estimable qualities, and possessed of hosts of friends, who will mourn her loss.
