ELLA C. SMITH

The death of Ella C. Smith occurred at her home in Newark Friday evening at the age of 45 years, following an illness of more than a year, in which she had been a great sufferer. She was born at Weedsport and had resided there, at Jordan and in Newark. Her maiden name was Hoyt and she married Charles L. Smith, of Newark, December 24, 1873 at Weedsport. She was for years a member of the Methodist church, but on locating in Newark became a member of the Universalist Church, in which she was uncommonly active before her illness began. She is survived by her husband and one daughter, Miss Letitia, of Newark, and by her mother, two brothers and one sister, all of Weedsport. The funeral will be held from the late residence at 9:30 this forenoon, Rev. F. M. Hayes of the Universalist Church officiating. Interment was made in the Rural cemetery at Weedsport. Mrs. Smith was one of the leading women off the Woman's Relief Corps of Newark until one year ago, and had a host of friends who will mourn her demise.
