Buried With Military Honors.

The remains of Harold S. Smith, recently brought to this country from France, where he was killed in action on Sept. 29th, 1918, were given a military funeral¹ last Saturday at Hunts, N.Y., where he was born in 1900. The services were held in Memorial Hall in Hunts and were in charge of Cecil Seager Post, American Legion, of Nunda.

The deceased resided in Perry for several years, and was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. Sanford Smith, who conducted a 5 and 10 cent store, removing later to Buffalo. He was a member of the Universalist Church of this place, and Rev. Clara Morgan officiated at the services.

Besides his parents he is survived by one sister, Florence.
