HERBERT F. SMITH

Dolgeville—Herbert F. Smith, 44, died unexpectedly Jan. 6, 1941, in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Otto Brosat, S. Main St. He was born in Fort Plain, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Ferdinand Smith. He came to Dolgeville 25 years ago. For the first five years he was co-operator of the Sherman-Smith Laundry. Since then he had been employed in the clerical department of the Daniel Green Company.
