Mrs. Eugene [Minna] Smith died last week at her home on Helmer avenue and the funeral was held from the home Saturday, Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton [Universalist] officiating. She had been ill of Bright's disease for a long time. Deceased was the daughter of Eri Timmerman and was born in Oppenheim in 1857. She was one of a family of eleven children. Her earthly life was spent in Oppenheim and after her marriage to Mr. Smith in 1877 she resided on a farm in that town up to a few years ago, when she came to this village. Mrs. Smith won many friends by her amiable character and excellent attributes, being a woman of homeloving disposition and tastes. She is survived by her husband; a son, Earl of this village; a daughter, Mrs. Martha Sutliff of Oppenheim; a brother, Delos Timmerman of Snells Bush, and a sister, Mrs. Nathaniel Hayes of Youkers Bush.
