Mrs. Anna Smither[s], 65, widow of Jeffry Smithers of Canton, and well known here, passed away on Monday afternoon at two o'clock at the Dunlap nursing home, where she was a patient over four months. She had been in failing health for nearly two years. Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon from the home and burial was made in Fairview cemetery. She was a daughter of Sanford L. and Emma Clark Barnes, born Sept. 30, 1877 at Brick Chapel. She married Jeffry Smithers on Sept. 5, 1900. He was for many years the business partner of Harold S.
