George H. Snell

George H. Snell, one of the village's best known citizens, died suddenly at noon Monday at his home on West Liberty street. Although his health had been poor for some time, he has been able to be around. Over the week end he complained of feeling worse, but his condition did not appear to be critical and Monday morning he seemed to be greatly improved. The fatal seizure came at noon, and he died before medical assistance could be summoned. Mr. Snell was born on June 8, 1881 in the town of Minden, a son of Hamilton Snell and Harriet Cronkhite Snell. He spent his entire life here. He was a Republican in politics. As a young man Mr. Snell clerked in local grocery stores and then entered the employ of Charles Walrath as a cigar maker. He was connected later with the firm of Sickler and Sweet. His jovial disposition and unfailing good humor won him many friends. Funeral services will be held from the home at two o'clock Thursday afternoon. Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton, pastor of the Universalist church of Dolgeville will officiate and burial will be made in Prospect View cemetery.
