Jane Ann Snell

Jane Ann Snell, aged 82 years, one of the most respected residents of Fort Plain, died at the home of John P. Snell Friday morning, after having been in poor health for a long time, although she had been confined to her bed for only six weeks. She was the widow of Peter B. Snell, and was born at Fordsbush. Her parents were the late Jacob Walrath and Betsy Coughry Walrath. Mrs. Snell was an ardent member of the Fort Plain Universalist church.

The survivors are four step-daughters and one step-son, Mrs. John M. [Catherine] Lipe of Fort Plain, Mrs. George [Alice Adia] Failing of Stone Arabia, Mrs. Peter C. [Ella] Wohlgemuth of the town of Palatine and Mrs. Willis [Naomi] Baird of Gloversville and John P. Snell of Fort Plain. The funeral was held at the home of John P. Snell Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, Rev. S.D. Butler, pastor of the Newport Universalist church, officiating. The interment was made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
