—Lansing D. Snell of this village passed away early Friday morning at the Little Falls hospital, where several days ago he underwent an operation for intestinal trouble, from which he had suffered for months. Mr. Snell was born in Inghams Mills 54 years ago and was the son of the late Lyman Snell. He spent his early life in that section and later came to this place where he was employed until a year ago by the Daniel Green Felt Shoe Co. He was an able baseball player some years ago and was the catcher of a battery, Graham and Snell, which achieved considerable distinction in the valley in those days. He had many friends and by all his death is much regretted. A particularly sad feature is the fact that his only son, Clifford, is now in Germany with the American forces. Knowing of his serious condition he had often expressed a desire to see the boy and efforts were made to have the boy released, but nothing could be done in the matter. Other relatives surviving are the wife, who was formerly Miss Elizabeth Thresher, a brother, William of Inghams Mills, and two sisters, Mrs. Susan Walrath of Inghams Mills and Mrs. Edwin Moyer of this village. The funeral was held from the late home Sunday, Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton [Universalist] officiating. Burial was made in the local cemetery.
