## Death Claims Mrs. F. Snook, Honeoye Falls

Honeoye Falls—Mrs. Annis C. Snook, 73, wife of Fred D. Snook, Honeoye Falls, died unexpectedly yesterday (May 14, 1943) in her home here.

She had been raking the lawn of her home in the morning and was stricken ill at noon and died at 3 p.m. of a brain hemorrhage.

Born in Victor on a farm, she was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Abijah Covell. Her girlhood was passed in Victor and her marriage to Fred Snook, relief agent for the Valley Railroad in Victor, occurred May 16, 1894. She and her husband would have observed their 49th wedding anniversary this coming summer.

For four years the couple operated a grocery and bakery store in Rochester and for the past 42 years had resided in Honeoye Falls. She took an active part in Presbyterian Church activities here and was a member of that church. She was an active member of the Ladies Aid Society and for a number of years supervised floral decoration of the church on Sundays, and also decorated the church for suppers and other church social events.

She was a member of the former Universalist Church of Victor and had served as president of the Ladies Aid Society of that church for several years. She was a member of the Fortnightly Club here.

She is survived by her husband; a sister, Mrs. Frank [Luna] Dibble of Victor; [and] a nephew, Roy Dibble, Victor.

Funeral will be Monday at 2:30 p.m. from the home with burial in Honeoye Falls Cemetery. The Rev. John F. Buyer of the Presbyterian Church will officiate.
