Obituary.

Warren B. Snow, the youngest of eight sons of Mr. and Mrs. Asa B. Snow, was born at Westmoreland, Oneida county, N.Y., October 22, 1836. He lived with his parents until he was eleven years of age when he came to Shongo to reside with his uncle Barnard Hawks. On April 22, 1856, he was united in marriage to Miss Sarah Boyce who then also resided at Shongo. One year later he and his wife came to Whitesville and located on the farm where he died September 18, 1902. To this union six children were born as follows: Mrs. Alice McGraw of Canisteo, W. L. Snow of Hornellsville, Mrs. Charles Casey of Middlesex, Mrs. L. H. [Carrie] Wildman, Bert W. Snow and Mrs. Luther [Jessie] Whitwood now residing in this vicinity. Mr. Snow is also survived by two brothers, A. L. Snow of Beatrice, Neb., and William S. Snow of Olean.

Mr. Snow was a gentleman who thought everything of home life, always doing what he could to make it happy, and in his death the whole community loses a good man.

The funeral services were held at the Universalist church, Saturday at 11 o'clock, Rev. L. [Lyman] H. Squires of Hornellsville officiating. Interment in the Baptist cemetery. Among those from away who attended the services were Burdette Boyce and family of Harrison Valley, Mr. and Mrs. B. C. Boyce of Wellsville, Miss Gerett Boyce of Buffalo, Miss Jennie Wilson of South Canisteo and Bernard Hawks of Shongo.
