JACOB SNYDER AGED 80, DIES IN FORT PLAIN

FORT PLAIN—Jacob Snyder, 80, died yesterday afternoon after an illness of four weeks, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Grace Smith, Reid street.

Born in the Town of Minden, November 20, 1862, the son of Henry and Catherine Hoke Snyder, he was a carpenter who retired in 1933. Since that time Mr. Snyder made his home with his daughter. His wife, who was Carrie Snell, died February 13, 1936.

Mr. Snyder was a member of Mohawk Valley Lodge No. 66, Knights of Pythias and of the Universalist church of Fort Plain.

He is survived by his daughter, Mrs. Smith; a son, Leland, of Hallsville; five grandchildren, one great-grandchild.

The funeral will be held at Mrs. Smith's home on Friday at 2 P.M., the Rev. William A. Haney, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist church, officiating. Burial will be made in the Mount Hope cemetery, Fords Bush.
