Victor, N. Y.—We have a very meager account of the sudden death of Mr. Joseph Snyder, a highly respected citizen of Victor, who was found dead in his bed last Friday morning, June 29th. He was feeling as well as usual the night before. He had at times complained of pain in the chest, but nothing serious was thought of it. The doctors concluded that he came to his death from heart disease. Mr. Snyder had resided in Victor for forty years. He was a member of the Universalist church. Two years ago his wife died. He left one son and two daughters.
