Funeral services were conducted today for Leland J. Snyder, 55, who died suddenly Friday evening at his home on Main Street following a heart attack.

Mr. Snyder was born in the Town of Danube, May 25, 1892, the son of Jacob and Carrie Snell Snyder. After selling his farm in the Town of Danube, which he conducted for many years, he bought a farm near Brookman's Corners which he operated with his son until about four years ago when he was forced to retire on account of ill health. He moved to Fort Plain where he purchased the home of Henry Rebell on Main Street. He was a member of the Fordsbush Universalist Church.

Surviving besides, his wife, the former Ruth Bellinger, is one son, Harlan, Valley Brook; two daughters, Mrs. Lester Zoller, Brookmans Corners, and Miss Lillian Snyder at home: one sister, Mrs. Grace Smith; Fort Plain; also three grandchildren.

Services were held at the Swartz funeral home at 2 P. M. with the Rev. H. H. Mahl officiating. Burial was made in Fort Plain Cemetery.
