The death of Adelbert Southern, a well-known resident of Morris, residing on the old road to West Laurens, occurred Tuesday afternoon. Mr. Southern had complained of illness for a week back. On Sunday morning he suffered a stroke of paralysis which rendered him unconscious and he remained in this state until he passed away.

The deceased was a son of the late James [and Harriet] Southern. He was fifty-six years of age and had been a life long resident of that vicinity. He is survived by his wife [Mary], and two children residing at New Berlin; also one brother, George Southern, and one sister, Mrs. Frances Hathaway, of Otsdawa. The funeral will be held from his late place of residence, Friday afternoon at 1 o'clock. The Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Leonard, pastor of the Universalist church, will officiate. Mr. Southern was a man held in high esteem by all who knew him and leaves a wide circle of friends who will be grieved to learn of his demise.
