William R. Southworth, for thirty years a resident of Cooperstown, died about five o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the M. L. Bassett Hospital. Mr. Southworth was born in Schuyler Lake on September 6, 1873, the son of William and Harriet Southworth. He attended the local school of that village, and spent their the greater part of his time until his removal to Cooperstown. In 1896 he married Jennie McRorie. He was a member of Oneonta Lodge, B.P.O.E., and the Sons of Veterans of Cooperstown.

During his long residence in Cooperstown he was a respected and well-known citizen, and for many years has attended the Universalist church. He is survived by his widow, one sister, Mrs. Thomas Shaw of Utica, and three brothers, Percy Southworth of Albany, Le Grand Southworth of Maryland, and Miles Southworth of Washington, D.C.

The funeral service will be held privately from his late residence on Saturday at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Geo. Boorn, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. Burial at Schuyler Lake. Friends who wish to pay their respects may call before that time.
