MRS. JAMES SPENCER DIES; CHURCH WOMAN 50 YEARS

Mrs. Caroline Victoria Yergason Spencer, of 520 6th st., South Brooklyn, widow of James Spencer, died on Monday at her home. Mrs. Spencer was born in New York City, and lived most of her lifetime in the Eastern District of Brooklyn. She had been for 50 years a member of All Souls Universalist Church, Ocean and Ditmas aves., joining the congregation when the Rev. Dr. Almon Gunnison was its pastor, when the church was located in the Eastern District. Until two years ago, when her health failed, Mrs. Spencer was one of the most active members of All Souls Church, its Lend-a-Hand Circle and its Women's League. She was before her marriage a teacher in the public schools of New York City. Mrs. Spencer is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Stephen [Amanda] Purdy, with whom she made her home, and Mrs. Harry F. Gill, and a sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Fleming. The funeral services will be held on Friday evening at Mrs. Spencer's late residence, conducted by the Rev. Dr. A. Eugene Bartlett, pastor of All Souls Church, and the interment, on Saturday, will be in Cypress Hills Cemetery.
