Marietta Payne Spicer

Mrs. Marietta Payne Spicer was born Apr. 20, 1848, daughter of Major and Orilla Harris Payne, and died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Bert Horton, Monday, Nov. 8, 1926. After a long, lingering illness, she passed into eternal sleep peacefully from a weakened condition of the heart.

In 1865 she was united in marriage to John M. Spicer, whose death occurred Feb. 25, 1916. Seven children were born to this union.

Of her immediate family, she is survived by five children: Herbert Spicer of Wellsville; Mrs. G. H. Woodcock of Saegerstown, Pa.; Mrs. Frank Landers of Cassadaga; Mrs. O. C. Perry and Mrs. Bert Horton, of Whitesville; Floyd having passed on in 1901, and Clementine on Oct. 22, 1925. She is survived by twelve grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren; also by one sister, Mrs. Emeline Payne. Mrs. Spicer being one of nine children.

Funeral services were conducted by Rev. C. L. Paddock [of Pigeon Cove, MA, a former local Universalist pastor] and Rev. R. S. Kellerman at the Universalist church Thursday afternoon. Interment was made in the family plot in Rural Cemetery.
