MRS. SARAH SPICER
Died Yesterday at the Advanced Age of 73 Years

Mrs. Sarah Spicer, one of the oldest and best known ladies in this township, died at the home of her son, D. G. [Daniel Grant] Spicer, yesterday afternoon at 1 o'clock. She had been in failing health for about two years, but was not confined to her bed until a few days ago. The cause of death is said to have been old age. The funeral services will be held at the residence to-morrow afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. E. Alice Bradley [Universalist] officiating.

Miss Sarah Jones was born March 4, 1831 at the Jones homestead on Cryder creek, where she resided until her marriage to Daniel Spicer, January 18, 1852. They then moved to the farm on West Hill where she died. To this union five children were born, three of whom are now living—R. E. Spicer of Spokane, Wash., Rev. N. R. Spicer of Attica, O., and D. G. Spicer, with whom she has resided. Her husband died in March, 21 years ago. Mrs. Spicer had always lived in the township and was well known and highly respected by all.
