G. W. SPRAGUE

George W. Sprague, 65 years old, well known farmer and one of the most respected citizens of Morris village, died suddenly at the family home on Grove street about 8:30 Thursday morning. Death was the result of stomach trouble with which he had long been afflicted.

Funeral services conducted by Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Morris of the Universalist church, were held from the family home Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment was in the family plot in the new part of Hillington cemetery.

Mr. Sprague was a native of the town of Burlington. He lived in Morris early in life and again later, his entire residence covering a period of 22 years.
