DEATHS.

In Marshall, September 20th, after a long illness, which a firm faith in the promises of God enabled him to support with exemplary patience, Dr. CONSIDER H. STACY, aged 46. This Christian brother, so led his life, as to gain the universal respect and esteem of every community in which he resided. Firmly attached to the principles of the Universalist faith, he showed the effects of those principles, in a well ordered life and conversation. He was a much esteemed member of the Medical profession. In bidding adieu to this life, Br. The funeral services of Br. S. were attended on the 22d, at the Universalist Church in Marshall, and a consolatory discourse was delivered by Joseph Sargent, of Cussewago, Pennsylvania. The remains of the deceased were taken to Earlville for interment.
