J. J. Steele Dead—

The death of Jeremiah J. Steele occurred at 7:30 last evening at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Charles [Carrie] Bell, in North Prospect street. The deceased was born Feb. 28, 1821, at Fort Herkimer, where he had always resided, pursuing the occupation of a farmer. In politics he was a Democrat. Although able to be about, he had been in failing health since December 24 last, and on February 18 he suffered a slight stroke of paralysis, the effect of which, together with old age, caused death. He was married January 16, 1856 to Miss Mary Edick, besides whom he leaves surviving daughters, Mrs. Charles Bell and Mrs. Adam J. Smith.
