T. H. STEEN, GROCER, DIES

MIDDLEPORT—A retired grocer, Thomas H. Steen, 89, of 11 Watson Ave., died Tuesday (Jan. 21, 1958) in Lockport Memorial Hospital, where he has [sic] been a patient for 10 days.

He was born in the Town of Royalton, May 3, 1868, and was a resident of this vicinity all his life. He and his brother, the late Robert Steen, operated a grocery store in this village for more than 40 years. He was a member of the First Universalist Church.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Dan Tinker, North Evans; a sister, Miss Hattie Steen, this village, and several nieces and nephews.
