DORA C. STEER DEAD AT HOME IN FORT PLAIN

Wife of Dr. H. G. Steer; Had Been Ill for Several Years; Native of the Village; Rites on Sunday

FORT PLAIN, March 26.—Mrs. Dora Casler Steer, 64, wife of Dr. H. G. Steer, died yesterday morning at her home following an illness of several years.
