Death of Alexander H. Stephens

On Thursday of last week Mr. Alexander H. Stephens, of Greenwood, departed this life, at the advanced aged of 79 years. He was one of the oldest inhabitants in the town, having lived there upwards of fifty years. He has not been actively engaged in business for many years, but in earlier life was an extensive lumberman, and accumulated a large property. He leaves two daughters [one of them having been Mary Stephens Woodbury], his wife having died about twenty years since. The son, Hon. R. D. Stephens, has represented his district in the Iowa Legislature, and is now President of two banks—the Merchant's National, of Cedar Rapids, and the First National, of Marion, Iowa.

The funeral obsequies were attended by a large concourse of relatives and friends, and were held at the late residence of the deceased on Sunday afternoon, the Rev. I. K. [Isaac Kirk] Richardson, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. The remains were interred in Greenwood cemetery. The deceased was an uncle of Messrs. G. L. Davis and M. Allison, of Canisteo.
