Miss Lurendo ^[sic] M. Stetson died at her home in this place, Sunday afternoon, June 21, 1903, of a complication of diseases, aged 61 years. She had been failing for the past 4 years. Deceased was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Reuben Stetson, and was born at Painted Post. For about 50 years she has been a resident of this village. Her parents died when she was eleven years of age. No immediate relatives are left, the nearest being a number of nephews and nieces as follows: Frank LaRue, Hemlock, Frances Marvin, Wayland, Mrs C. E. Shattuck, Cleveland, Mrs. Jacob Mehlenbacher, Salamanca, Clarence Haight and Mrs. Stanlake, Ovid, Mich. She was a member of, and when in health, an active worker in the Universalist church. The funeral was held Tuesday forenoon, Rev. H. [Herbert] P. Morrell of Buffalo, conducting the services. Interment in Maple View cemetery.
