SERENO STICKNEY Aged Resident of Crittenden Died From Apoplexy—His Funeral

CORFU, June 19.—Sereno Stickney, aged 77 years, died at his home $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Crittenden on June 15th. He had been confined to the bed about three weeks, but the immediate cause of death was a stroke of apoplexy.

When a young man Mr. Stickney married Miss Julia Gay and began housekeeping at the place where he died, having lived there about 52 years. Besides his wife he is survived by two sons, Luman Stickney of this place and John Stickney, who lived at home. The funeral was held from the house yesterday afternoon, the Rev. Harry Wright [Universalist] of Corfu officiating. The interment was at Clarence.
