ARVINE STILES  
Death, This Morning, Followed Six Weeks' Illness

Arvine Stiles, 72, passed away this morning at 5 o'clock at his home, 51 Lincoln Avenue, following an illness of about six weeks. Mr. Stiles had previously enjoyed fine health and it was his first serious illness.

Mr. Stiles was born in Georgetown, Madison county, May 6, 1856 and he lived for many years in the vicinity of Summer Hill and Lake Como in Cayuga county. He came to live in this city about 22 years ago. He was a member of the Universalist Church of this city.

He is survived by two sons, Walter D. Stiles of Cortland and Earl J. Stiles of the town of Homer, and seven grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home, 51 Lincoln Avenue. Rev. J. [Joseph] A. Judge, pastor of the Universalist Church of this city, to officiate. The body will be placed in the receiving vault of the Cortland Rural cemetery to await burial in the spring.
