Mrs. Bertha Stiles Dies in Canton Nursing Home

Mrs. Bertha Farmer Stiles, widow of Albert E. Stiles, passed away at 7:30 on Monday evening, January 15, at the Canton Nursing Home. Funeral services were held from the Lawrence funeral home on Wednesday at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Edna Bruner [Universalist] officiating. The body was placed in the vault at Evergreen cemetery to await burial in the spring.

Mrs. Stiles was born [on] December 11, 1862, in Canton, daughter of Lauren Farmer and Marian Johnson Farmer. She was married on January 12, 1888 to Albert E. Stiles, who died in March, 1922.
