MRS. JULIA¹ STILES, 83, PASSES AWAY AT CANTON FUNERAL OF WIDOW OF EZRA STILES WILL BE HELD WEDNESDAY.

Canton, Dec. 26. Mrs. Julia Stiles, aged 83 years, widow of Ezra Stiles, died at the home of her son, Bert Stiles, yesterday moring about 10, following a paralytic stroke. She was stricken on Thursday night and never regained consciousness, though at times she was in a semi-conscious condition. She has [had] been in very good health until this last illness and in spite of her advanced age was able to get around very well. Since the death of her husband several years ago [in 1914] she had made her home with her son, Frank Stiles, in Potsdam and for the past two years with her son, Bert Stiles, at Canton.

Mrs. Stiles was the daughter of Augustus and Mary Jane Clark of North Russell, the Clark family being one of the first to open up that territory and settle there. She was married at the age of 18 years to Ezra Stiles, a farmer, and lived in the vicinity of Russell until about 25 years ago when Mr. Stiles retired and moved to Canton. She is survived by a sister, Mrs. R. G. Carr of Cleveland, O.; a brother, Julius Clark of Russell; two sons, Bert Stiles of Canton and Frank Stiles of Potsdam.

The funeral will be held here on Wednesday afternoon from the residence of Bert Stiles, Dr. James M. Payson [Universalist] officiating, and burial will be in the cemetery at North Russell.
