ALBION, Dec. 3—Burton T. Stockton, 80, lifelong resident here and at one time owner and operator of the Stockton Bakery on North Main Street, died early today (Dec. 3, 1956) at the Arnold Gregory Memorial Hospital after an illness of six weeks.

He was a member of the local Odd Fellows Lodge and was presented a 50-year pin by that group in 1954. He attended the Universalist Church and was employed for many years by the Snider Packing Corp. until his retirement in 1944.

He leaves two sons, Burton Stockton of Batavia and Harold Stockton of Warren, Ohio; 11 grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren; a brother, Charles Stockton of Albion; a sister, Mrs. Raymond Griswold of Medina, and a niece.
