WAS PROFESSOR AT ST. LAWRENCE U. FOR 34 YEARS Husband of Fort Native Expires at Canton

Funeral services for Professor Frederick William Storrs, 77, husband of the former Ina Cushman of Fort Covington, who died at Canton July 12, were held from his home there last week Wednesday afternoon, and interment was made in Fairview cemetery in Canton.

Professor Storrs was a member of the chemistry department of St. Lawrence university for 34 years, joining the faculty there in 1908 and retiring six years ago.

Following the death of his first wife, Mr. Storrs married the former Miss Cushman December 26, 1911 at Fort Covington. She is a graduate of the state institute at Canton, and was teaching dietetics at Hepburn hospital, Ogdensburg, at the time of her marriage.

Professor Storrs was a member of various scientific organizations and of the Canton Universalist church.

Surviving besides his wife are two sisters, Mrs. John L. Golden of Syracuse and Mrs. Leonard F. Hutchison of Malone, and one brother, Dr. Berton W. Storrs of Portsmouth, R.I.
