Mrs. Mary Richardson Stratton died last Wednesday evening, at the home of Calvin Cobb, in this place, after a long illness of consumption. Mrs. Stratton was born in the town of Perinton, March 6, 1831. Her parents were Selleck and Polly Richardson. She married Holley Stratton, October 26, 1858, and two children were born to them, who now survive. They are Ada Stratton Gates of Republic, Washington, and Ambrose Stratton of Rochester. Mr. and Mrs. Stratton lived in Dakota, for ten years, where Mr. Stratton died. She, with her son, came to this town, soon after the death of her husband, and has since resided here. The Wednesday before the new year, she was obliged to seek her bed and has since been confined there, until death released her from her suffering last Wednesday. The funeral was held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. I. K. Richardson [Universalist] officiated, assisted by Rev. George Stratton, brother-in-law of the deceased. Interment was made in the Rural cemetery.
