The death of Charles W. Taber occurred late yesterday afternoon at his home on the Steuben road, just north of German street, in this village. He had been ill in bed since Tuesday. Mr. Taber was 64 years old and was born south of Middleville in the town of Herkimer and resided on a farm before taking up his residence in this village 16 years ago. For several years he was employed as engineer at the plant of the West Canada Lumber Company. His wife whose maiden name was Amanda Ferris died in 1908. Mr. Taber was highly regarded by all and his many friends will regret his death. The funeral will be held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from his late home, the Rev. Charles E. Bingham [Universalist] officiating. Two daughters, Mrs. Frank Wynn of Mohawk and Miss Jennie Taber of this village, and two sons, Warren of Iliion and Harry C. Taber of Herkimer, are surviving.
