Mrs. Alice J. Talcott of 175 North St., born in Buffalo 84 years ago, died yesterday after a short illness. She is survived by her husband, Fred L. Talcott, retired division freight agent of the New York Central Railroad. On last September 1st Mr. and Mrs. Talcott celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.

The funeral will be tomorrow at 2:30 p.m. at the Johnson & Wilkins Funeral Home, 448 Delaware Ave., the Rev. Dr. Bruce Swift, minister of North Presbyterian Church, and the Rev. Dr. A. Lynn Booth of Universalist Church officiating. Burial will be in Forest Lawn.

Daughter of the late John and Joanna Hill Chamberlain, Mrs. Talcott was a lifelong resident of Buffalo except for a short period when she lived in Erie, Pa. For 60 years she was an active member of the Universalist Church.

Her son, John C. Talcott, who died in 1929, was chief engineer of the Pierce Arrow Co. Her grandchildren, Mary Jane Talcott and Mrs. Robert Driscoll, both of Buffalo, survive.
