For the past 37 years she had resided in Auburn. She was a member of the Women's Relief Corps of the G.A.R.

Surviving Mrs. Tallman are two daughters, Miss Nellie Tallman and Mrs. Fred D. Searles, both of Auburn; two brothers, Charles E. Shoemaker and William Shoemaker of Washington, D.C.; and one sister, Mrs. Charles Dean of Washington, D.C.; also grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 3:30 Friday afternoon, at the family home. Rev. Harry Wright [Universalist] of Bristol will officiate. Burial will be in Fort Hill Cemetery.
