MRS. FRED TANNER

Salisbury Center—Mrs. Mabel Tanner, 68, a life-long resident of this community, died Jan. 21, 1953 in Little Falls Hospital, where she had been a patient for a day.

Mrs. Tanner was born on Apr. [3?], 1884 in Salisbury Center, a daughter of John and Alwida Comstock Moyer. Her marriage to Fred Tanner took place Jan. 25, 1902.

Mrs. Tanner was a member of the Universalist Church and the local grange.

She leaves her husband, a son, Lynn Tanner, Oneida; a daughter, Mrs. Gertrude McArthur, and a sister, Mrs. Arthur Rogers, both of Salisbury Center; two grandsons and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral will be at 2 p.m. tomorrow from the Universalist Church, the Rev. Gale Bascombe officiating. The body will be placed in the Dolgeville Cemetery vault for burial in Salisbury Center in the spring.
