WILLIAM H. THAYER Death of a Lifelong Resident of the Vicinity of Corfu

Corfu, June 28.—William H. Thayer, a lifelong resident of this vicinity, died at his home on Allegheny street at 10:15 o'clock on Saturday night from capillary bronchitis. He underwent an operation at his home on December 18th last and from which he recovered sufficiently to be about, but he did not regain his former strength and a week ago last night he took to his bed.

Mr. Thayer was born on the Thayer farm in Darien, two miles south of Corfu, on March 31, 1846, and on April (20? 29?) 1871 he married Miss Emily E. Butler of Darien, who survives him, together with two daughters, Mrs. E.T. Sumner and Miss Florence M. Thayer, all of Corfu.

The funeral will be held from the house at 2:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon, the Rev. Harry M. Wright [Universalist] of Lockport officiating. The interment will be in the Evergreen Hill cemetery.
