MRS. ABRAHAM THOMAS Resident of Corfu Dead at the Home of Her Son, J. E. Rogers

CORFU, Aug. 28.—Mrs. Abbie Thomas died at the home of her son, J. E. Rogers, on Saturday at 6:15 p.m., after a long illness of dropsical trouble.

Mrs. Thomas was born in Massachusetts on July 16, 1818, being 87 years of age. In early girlhood she moved with her parents to Monroe county and in October, 1840, she was married to Daniel Rogers of Rochester, who died in 1872. In 1884 she was united in marriage to Abraham Thomas, and during fifty years of her life she was a resident of Darien. She enjoyed the respect of all who knew her. She is survived, besides J. E. Rogers, by two sons, Daniel Rogers of Syracuse and George Rogers of Batavia; a daughter, Mrs. Mary F. Rumble of California, and a sister, Mrs. Emeline Webster of Michigan.

The funeral will be held from the home of J. E. Rogers tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Harry Wright [Universalist] officiating. The interment will be in the Alden and Darien cemetery.
