David Thomas, aged 87 years, died at his home in Holcomb, Sunday morning, following a few days' illness with pneumonia after grippe. He was born in the town of Bristol. For 15 years he operated what was known as the Thomas mill at South Bloomfield. He had been a resident of Holcomb for 30 years. His wife, who was Miss Hannah Bentley, of Richmond, died in November, 1918. Mr. Thomas as a well known and popular violinist and for many years conducted a dance orchestra in this section. He had been a member of Canandaigua lodge, F. & A.M. for 54 years. Deceased leaves two daughters, Mrs. Emma Mitchell of Rochester and Mrs. John Newton of Holcomb.

Funeral services were held from the home, Tuesday at 2 o'clock, Rev. O. [Otis] F. Alvord of Bristol Universalist Church officiating. Interment was made in Bristol.
