The death of Mrs. Hannah M. Thomas occurred at her home on Saturday evening November 30th after a lingering illness.

Funeral services were held from her late home at 2 o'clock on Tuesday afternoon, conducted by Rev. O. [Otis] F. Alvord, pastor of the Universalist church at Bristol. Interment was in the Bristol cemetery.
